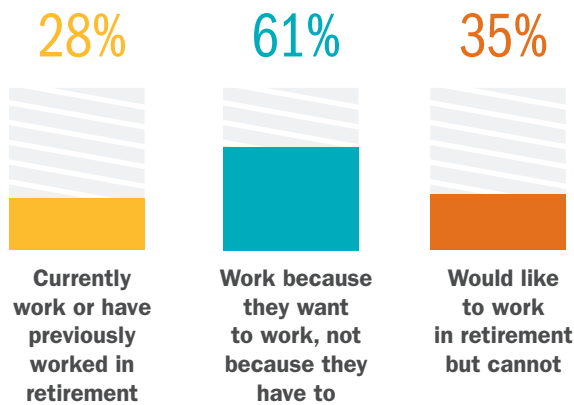




# New Expectations, New Rewards: Work in Retirement for Middle-Income Boomers

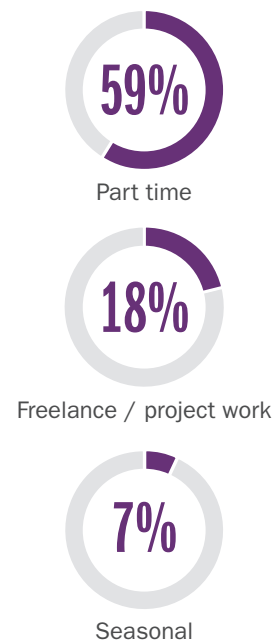
Middle-income Boomers view work as a part of their retirement experience. They work because they want to work, primarily for nonfinancial reasons.
